BabySteps Per Diem Rate Schedule

BabySteps: Willow House

BabySteps is a community home for pregnant teens and young mothers, ages 13-19, located in the greater Richmond area. The focus of BabySteps is to provide a supportive and encouraging environment while preparing young mothers to appropriately care for themselves and their child(ren) while developing the family unit. BabySteps provides individual, group and family therapy, and involves the father, if and when appropriate. BabySteps helps young mothers learn about and develop community supports, both during placement and in their own communities. BabySteps offers its young mother's the opportunity to complete their education, develop plans for a career, and learn practical parenting skills ensuring success for the family. BabySteps is designed to work with pregnant teens, pregnant teens with a child under the age of 5, and young mothers with children under age 5.

Additional Fees

Parenting 2 Children Additional Room and Board \$51.50/day

24/7 Medical Assistance \$82.40/ day

This additional fee is added after a youth has been in the hospital for 3 days due to medical issues/complications with their pregnancy or pre or post delivery and require an extended stay in the hospital, around the clock supervision, monitoring and or nurturing. This service allows the youth to have a trained worker by their side 24 hours a day for as long as needed.

1. For Medicaid-eligible residents, Therapeutic Behavioral Services for Children and Adolescents under age 21 (Level B) are reimbursed by Virginia Medicaid at the rate of \$146.22 per day. The Procedure Codes are H2020-HW (CSA) and H2020-HK (non-CSA).

Optional Services not included in the Comprehensive Daily Rate:

360 – Therapeutic Mentoring & Life Skills Coaching \$49.28 per hour

360 Therapeutic Mentoring is available to all school aged children under the age of 21. Mentoring focuses on life skills training, anger management, social skills training, leadership, academic support.

1:1 Parent Educator \$51.50 per hour

The program provides additional 1:1 support, and training for the youth. The program focuses on the development of a relationship that enhances the youth's capacity for companionship, enhancing parenting skills, educational performance, social and independent living skill proficiency, coping mechanisms, and communication skills. The Parent Educator Program also provides anger management, leadership development, self-esteem building, conflict resolution, helps link to volunteering opportunities and character building
